TRUST THE MISSION

We have seen God's love spelt out on the cross. We have chosen to follow Him. We have joined the army of the Lord. And Christ has given us a top-not-secret mission. We are to journey to heaven and bring as many with us as we can.

However, the rules of engagement sometimes seem a little fuzzy. The way forward is shrouded in mystery. Reinforcements seem unduly delayed, and the personal sacrifice too high. Yet this is exactly when we need to trust our Commander, obey our orders, and have faith in the mission. "God is too wise to err, and too good to withhold any good thing from them that walk uprightly. Then do not fear to trust Him, even though you do not see the immediate answer to your prayers" SC 96.

There will be days when the Christian struggle threatens to overwhelm you. If not today, then soon. The temptation then will be to do more, to try harder, to soldier on in your own strength. Don't. Stop and rest. Use the Sabbath principle to be still, to pray, to read God's Word, and to connect with your Lord and King. And HE will trim your lamp until it becomes a lighthouse. HE will hone your sword sharper than Gabriel's. HE will give you the strength of Samsom, and the wisdom of Solomon. And HE will prepare a path and table before you in the presence of your enemies.

You may be sacred. You may be bewildered. That's okay. The Great Controversy does not depend on you knowing everything. Just trust in Jesus... and believe in the mission.
